



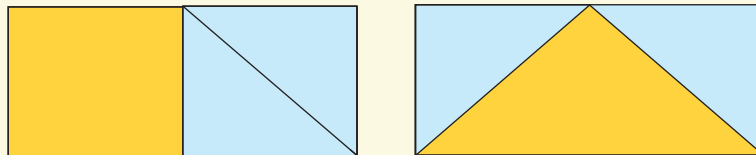
Quilt Block Directions

Finished block size is 11" x 11". Please DO NOT square the blocks! Use ¼" seam allowance.

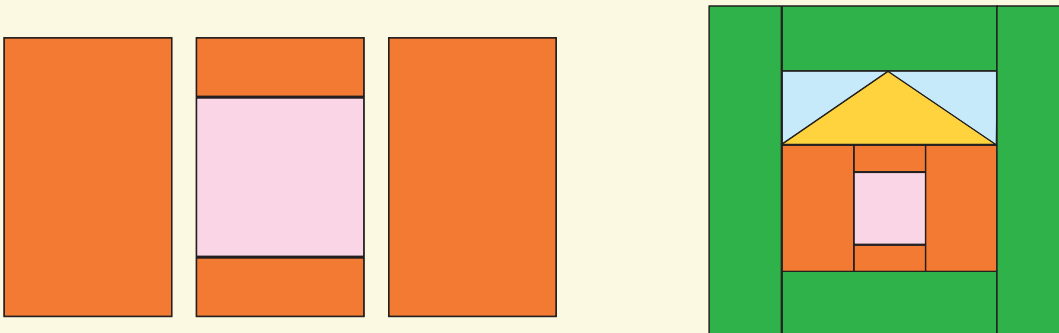
- Cut 1: 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle for roof
- Cut 2: 3 ⅞" squares for sky (blue please)
- Cut 1: 2 ½" square for window (no stripes)
- Cut 2: 2 ½" x 1 ½" rectangle for house

- Cut 2: 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles for house
- Cut 2: 2 ¾" x 6 ½" rectangles for frame
- Cut 2: 3" x 11 ½" rectangles for frame

Draw a diagonal line on the 3 ⅞" sky squares. Sew a sky square on the diagonal to each side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" roof rectangle by aligning the bottom and side of the square with the rectangle. The top of the square will hang off the top of the roof. Press first triangles into corner before adding the second triangle. Press second triangle into corner. Trim extra sky fabric across the top. Trim extra fabric behind each triangle.



Sew the two 2 ½" x 1 ½" house rectangles to the top and bottom of the 2 ½" square window. Press the seams away from the window. Then sew the 4 ½" x 2 ½" house rectangles to the sides of the window unit. Press the seams away from the window.



Sew the roof unit to the house unit. Sew the 2 ¾" x 6 ½" frame rectangles to the top and the bottom of the house. Press toward the frame. Sew the 3" x 11 ½" frame rectangles to the sides of the house block. Press toward the frame.
